Purchasing Digital eBooks and Personal Device usage

Dear Parents/Guardians

A number of parents have expressed concern that the College bag is too heavy for students in Secondary. In order to assist you, the College Executive have approved that students may purchase the Digital eBooks, rather than the hard-copy textbook.

However, there are a number of conditions that you need to be aware of:

- All eBooks must be installed on your own personal devices. The College will not be providing devices for personal use for students.
- It is your own responsibility that the device is charged each day and maintained by your son/daughter for the use at the College.
- BYOD-WiFi is available to access resources, provided that your son/daughter has signed the BYOD/ICT contract.
- The student must take full responsibility to ensure that their device is not damaged or misplaced. The College will not be held responsible for any damages occurred at school.

If you agree to all of the above conditions then you are more than welcome to purchase a Digital copy of the textbook, if it is available.
