**News from the ICT Committee: BYOD and Accessing WiFi** - The College has been upgrading its ICT services and has introduced BYOD for students. Currently students in Yrs 9-12 have been given access. The plan to enable WIFI for students is as follows: Yrs 7 and 8 students by 8<sup>th</sup> August; Yrs 5 and 6 students by

22<sup>nd</sup> August; Yrs 3 and 4 students by 5<sup>th</sup> September; and K-2 students by 11<sup>th</sup> October.

The 2016 NAPLAN results are due to schools on Tuesday the 16<sup>th</sup> of August and should be sent home to parents by Wednesday the 17<sup>th</sup> of August.

**Census: Collection of information about schools -** The Australian Government provides funding to Australian schools under the Australian Education Act 2013. That Act and the associated Australian Education Regulation 2013 require that your child's school provide the Australian Government with certain information about the school, its financial arrangements, and its student body, in order that the funding is properly calculated and accounted for. Please read the attached Census letter to parents.

From the PESN: All About Bullying - Around 1 in 4 Australian students have experienced bullying at some point. It's therefore crucial that schools take steps to create safer environments for students. However, as parents it is also possible to take action against bullying. It is important to know what bullying is, why people bully and how to recognise bullying. Teaching your child how to handle bullying and the importance of empathy and positive relationships comprise preventative measure to ensure bullying does not arise.
