From the PESN: 'Latest Research: Digital Participation' - In June 2016, the Office of the Children's eSafety Commissioner undertook a national survey of kids, teens and parents who use the internet. Parents were asked about their approach to online safety, and what information they need to support their children to be safe online. Kids aged 8 to 13 and teens aged 14 to 17 were asked detailed questions about their internet use and online practices, including how they manage their negative experiences online.
