From a young age children need to be taught resolution skills to assist them in addressing challenges and difficult periods. When a parent allows a child to quit and change to make things easier, it allows for the child to develop the habit of avoidance. Eventually, this habit after so many repetitions becomes a life pattern, which is difficult to break.
