

- All eBooks must be installed / accessed on personal devices. The College will not be providing devices for personal use for students – unless they are borrowed for Learning Support students.
- It is your own responsibility that the device is charged each day and maintained by you for use at College. Teachers will not be charging your devices for you if the battery is low.
- BYOD-WiFi is available to access your resources, once you have signed the BYOD/ICT Contract.
- The student must take full responsibility to ensure that their device is not damaged or misplaced in any manner. The College will not be held responsible if damage does occur to their device.
