Story of the Maronite Sisters of the Holy Family

Patriarch Elias Howayek was convinced that the future of any Country relied on the education of young girls, as they were the mother to be, the heart of the family, which in turn was the foundation of society. Through education, they would become positive contributors in shaping the values of a Nation.

Patriarch Elias Howayek, along with Sr Rosalie Nasr and Sr Stéphanie Kardouche, founded 'The Congregation of the Maronite Sisters of the Holy Family' (MSHF) in North Lebanon.

The Congregation was the first female religious missionary Congregation of the Maronite Patriarchal Rite, and historically was 'founded for' the ministry of service to the Church through education, for the betterment of society.

Established in 1895 the Congregation from the very beginning focused on the needs of the times, committed to educational, humanitarian and spiritual service to all. The mission of the Congregation has since expanded to include numerous coeducational schools, care of the elderly and the sick through the ministry of nursing, and ongoing pastoral ministry in parishes.

Students of the MSHF are encouraged to grow holistically with focus on the spiritual as well as the academic and social dimensions of the person. Students are nurtured in faith, challenged academically, and encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities, so as to positively contribute to society at large, shaping a positive future for all.
