
MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL - Sr Margaret Ghosn



Rapid Antigen Testing

A reminder that students should do a Rapid Antigen Test every Monday and Wednesday mornings before coming to the College.

If a positive result is received, the following are required to be done:

- 1. Report the positive result through Service NSW
- 2. Report the positive result to the College
- 3. Follow the HSW health advice on isolating.

Students who are identified as household close contacts are also required to isolate and notify the College.
