Pacer Rebate - Year 6 Canberra Excursion

In week 8, September 7 to 9, the year 6 students will be going on an excursion to Canberra to undertake an education tour of the National Capital. Students will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage, and democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the National Capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.

<u>Secondary Excursions – Permission</u>

Starting Monday 12th September, all students must give permission for an event **via the parent portal.** Emails, hand-written notes, or phone calls will not be accepted. If permission is not given via the portal, the student cannot attend the event.

Church Carpark – 19th September 2022
