Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware, the College moved to a new software program for fees and billing this year. Your patience and understanding while we trialed new ways to communicate this information to you is appreciated.

After much feedback and suggestions from you, we have decided to condense the categories on the two billing runs for 2023.

Year 12 graduation will be invoiced separately, as will any other excursions or activities that your child will be invited to attend.

The **first invoice** will include the Tuition fee, Academic Levy, Extra-Curricular Levy and the school maintenance fee (charged per family).

The Academic Levy will cover the cost of resources, service fees, mandatory course costs and related excursions/incursions.

The Extra- Curricular Levy will cover school camps, sporting programs/excursions that are not related to a particular subject.

Sibling discounts of 15% for the second child and 20% for the third child will be applied to tuition. Fourth child's tuition fee will attract a 100% discount.

The **second invoice** relates to high school electives and elective excursions. This will be invoiced at the end of March / early April to allow your child enough time to decide if the subjects selected are the ones they would like to complete for the next two years.

Payment options

- Direct Debit is the preferred method of payment. Forms are available from the school office or the Parent Portal. Payments can be deducted weekly, fortnightly or monthly, and spread across the school year.
- Online Internet transfer payments (details on the bottom of your invoice). Please quote your surname and ID number for reference.
- If you receive a Centrelink payment, another option for payment would be through CENTREPAY. Forms are available from the school office.
- EFTPOS over the phone or in the admin office
- CASH paid at the admin office.
- Four set instalments - dates to be confirmed in 2023.

Unfortunately, cheques will no longer be accepted from 2023.
