Maronite College of the Holy Family's Policies and Procedures reflect current legislation, requirements, standards and provide important information to parents. Here is a short précis of each Policy and Procedure available on the College website.

Child Protection Policy and Procedures states the new Child Safe Standards (2022) and includes a complaint form for grievances or concerns of staff misconduct for all stakeholders (parents, students and community).

- 1. Enrolment Policy and Procedures articulates the contractual agreement with the College.
- 2. Student Attendance Policy and Procedures provides information about the College attendance system including absenteeism.
- 3. Student Behaviour Management Policy and Procedures articulates the roles and responsibilities of students, College expectations and procedural fairness.
- 4. Student Welfare Policy and Procedures sites the plethora of leadership and wellbeing programs available to students.
- 5. *Anti-Bullying Policy and Procedures* defines the types of bullying, College proactivity, support services available and includes a Bullying Complaints form for students and parents.
- 6. Student Uniform and Grooming Policy states College expectations and standards.
- 7. Complaints Handling Policy and Procedures for All Stakeholders includes the processes for raising and responding to matters of concern identified by students' parents and community members.
- 8. RoSA and HSC Curriculum and Assessment Policy and Procedures contains everything parents need to know academically from Years 7-12.
- 9. *Primary Curriculum and Assessment Policy and Procedures* contains everything parents want to know from Kindergarten to Year 6.
- 10. *Privacy Policy, Plan and Procedure* articulates your right to privacy and includes the Confidential Agreement signed annually to ensure parents and students right to privacy is maintained.
- 11. Whistle Blowing Policy and Procedure defines and articulates the requirements and procedure.
- 12. Fee Policy and Procedure informs parents of the purpose, collection procedure and support available.
